

## NEWS FLASH FROM COLDWATER, ON

The Coldwater Shuffleboard has been the target of vandalism in the past year or more.

It may not have been intentional, but the results are the same. The challenge was always there for teenagers with little else to do, but to climb up on the roof of the Curling Arena and jump down on to the roof of the Shuffleboard Club's fiberglass storage building.

After a prolonged period of roof top "free style jumping" without parachutes, the teenagers finally broke through the fiberglass panels and eventually destroyed the roof. The club then contacted Carl Rogerson of North Bay ON who sells new and used shipping containers.



The Shuffleboard club purchased a 20ft shipping container from Carl and had it delivered on site on Aug 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2012.

The all steel container will be very useful for additional storage, not to mention more durable to withstand any further unexpected vandalism.

The Coldwater Shuffleboard Club was also recipients of 150 padded chairs that were donated by the Township of Severn. The padded chairs will replace the solid seat chairs currently in use by the club. The only item left is for the club to paint the container to blend in with the Curling Club.
