TREASURER'S REPORT. Read by treasurer Durelle Kowacz. (copy of same included in minutes.) Bill Boyes wanted item changed to read Tournament Director, not just Director, listed in the expense column.

COMMITTEE REPORTS. Lorraine had nothing to report on tournament **director.** Bev Fowler, stated that membership overall is down. Has signed up 147 members this year, which is down by 75 members over last 6 years, confirmed by Durelle as well, as she also looked into this. We really need to promote shuffleboard. Bill Boyes, (reporting on the web,) has been going well, would like more articules sent in to him, need to keep everyone informed as to what may be happening in our clubs, and with our members. George O'Reilly, Keeper of Records, states that the yearly points that have been awarded to players this year, will be on the web in the next week or so. Bill Boyes will put them on the web.
