9th Canadian National Shuffleboard Championship Blenheim, Ontario June 16 – 20, 2025

I am pleased to present this application form for the Canadian National Shuffleboard Championship in Blenheim next summer. It's a great opportunity to meet other players from across the country, or reunite with former opponents from past IPs, and especially, to **bring home the gold for Ontario**.

Application forms will be reviewed and evaluated by a committee. Scores will be tallied so that the average score from the independent reviewers will be used to determine an overall average score. Scores will be weighted most heavily towards skill (70%). The remaining 30% will take OSA tournament participation, previous IP experience, and special circumstances into account. At this point, we do not know the number of players required from Ontario. Typically, we will be asked to fill in empty slots. This means you should apply if you want to play.

It is imperative you complete the form to the best of your ability. It is the only thing the selection committee has to accurately give you a score. Assume the committee does not know how you did in Florida or Texas or wherever last year (or Ontario for that matter).

Please review the attached paperwork from the CNSA regarding costs, rules, a release to be signed by those qualifying to play, and other important information. Forward all questions to me and I'll get the answer.

Ignore the dates stated on the CNSA paperwork with respect to application and payment deadlines. Applications must be received by me on or before January 31 to be accepted for consideration. Immediately after being selected, applicants will be instructed on sending in the release form and payment to the OSA. We hope to have everything decided before February 15.

Please note that this facility **does not** have an elevator, however there is a ramp that has access to the 2nd floor lounge/dining area, a restroom and full viewing area of playing surface. Main washrooms/change areas are located on the lower level which must be accessed via stairs.

Player & Non-Player Information:

The **CNSA** strongly encourages all players and non-players to purchase "Out-of-Province" insurance.

Canadian National Shuffleboard Championship deadline for registration from each province by: **March 1, 2025**

Cancellation requests received prior to **March 15. 2025** fully refunded; between **March 16 and March 31**, 50% refunded; after **April 1, 2025** no refund.

In the event of tournament cancellation 90% refund until May 1st, 2025.

Players fees cover the cost of rental and use of **The Golden Acres Shuffle Club** facilities, "Meet and Greet" event with appetizers, five lunches, Wednesday night pig roast and the Awards Banquet. **Cash bar will be available.**

Players are expected to wear uniforms representing their province, bring provincial memorabilia (pins or the like) if you would like to exchange with other players and wear closed-toe shoes during play.

We recommend flying into London or Windsor Airport. They both are approximately 1 hour from Chatham.

Transportation from and back to the airports will be at the player's own expense.

Transportation to and from the venue will be at the player's own expense.

FYI: taxi service would be very expensive (22 kms) and would take 20-25 minutes to travel from hotel to playing venue.
